The School Day from September 2024: In March 2022, the Department for Education set out the government's expectation that all schools should deliver a minimum school week of 32.5 hours by September 2024 for children in Reception to Year 6 (nursery hours remain the same).

Our school, along with a number of other schools in the local area, needs to make some minor changes to the school week in order to comply with this expectation. After a period of consultation, it has been agreed by governors that the following changes will be made:

#### **Currently:**

Start of school day 8.55am (children may enter school from 8.45am) End of school day 3.15pm

### From September 2024:

Start of school day 8.55am (children may enter school from 8.45am) End of school day 3.25pm (all classes, except nursery)

This change will take effect from the children's return to school on Wednesday, 4th September 2024.



World Book Day takes place on Thursday, 7th March. I am giving another reminder as we are inviting all children to come to school dressed as a book character. Staff will also be joining in! Costumes can be made or bought. I have noticed that many charity shops currently have a special rail for World Book Day which is a great way of getting a bargain. However, if you are struggling to source a

costume, please contact school - we will ensure that no child misses out. Any donations of costumes which your child has grown out of would be welcomed. This is a great day which gives us an opportunity to celebrate children's literature and promote reading.

Children have also come home today with their World Book Day voucher. The voucher entitles your child to one free World Book Day book or £1.00 off a book or audio book costing £2.99 or more. You can find a list of the free World Book Day books here:
